Register the name of the Members of the  
Petitioner Association whose names are listed in  
the list of Members (Annexure P-2), in the  
Register of Registrar, Punjab Nurses Registration  
Council and Haryana Nurses Registration Council  
i.e. Respondent No. 3 & 4, who have done their  
Multi Purpose Health Workers (Female) Vocational  
Course from Para Medical Council, Punjab (Regd.)  
but their names are not being registered by the  
Respondent No. 3 & 4 on the ground that the Para  
Medical Council, Punjab (Regd.) is not recognized  
by the Punjab Nurses Registration Council or the  
Haryana Nurses Registration Council and is not in



the list of Indian Nursing Council, whereas the Respondent No. 3 & 4 are registering the names of the students of Govt. Model Sr. Sec. School, Sector 15, Chandigarh, which is not recognized by the Punjab Nursing Council and is not in the list of Indian Nursing Council and thus a step motherly treatment has been done with the members of the Petitioner Association who have passed / done their Multi Purpose Health Workers (Female) Vocational Course from Para Medical Council, Punjab (Regd.).

With further prayer that during the pendency of this writ petition, the respondent no. 3 & 4 may kindly be directed to Register the name of the members of the Petitioner Association, provisionally, so that they can earn their livelihood, in the interest of justice.

**Respectfully States:**

1. That the petitioner is an association of students who have passed / done Multi Purpose Health Workers (Female) Vocational Course from Para Medical Council, Punjab (Regd.) but their names are not being registered in the Register of Registrar, Punjab Nurses Registration Council and the Haryana Nurses Registration Council i.e. Respondent No. 3 & 4. The petitioner association has authorized its President Ms. Bhavneet to file the present Writ Petition. The copy of the resolution dated 23.11.2010 passed by the petitioner association in this regard is annexed herewith as **Annexure P-1**. The petitioner association is situated in Punjab and its all members are citizen of India and as such the petitioner is in a position to invoke the writ jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India by way of filing the present writ petition. Present petition has been filed by an association of Multi Purpose Health Workers (Female). They have prayed for a direction that members of the association be granted registration for purpose of practicing as Nurses Midwives, Multi Workers, Health Workers etc.

At the outset, learned counsel for the Nurses Registration Council (respondents No.3 & 4 herein) submit that in case individual applications are submitted by members of the association, same would be considered as per law.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. The writ petition is hereby disposed of. It is made clear that as and when an application is received from the members of the association, decision thereon shall be taken by the Council, in any case not later than one month of receipt of such application.
